Who is responsible for the accreditation of basic medical education in your country?

- Previously, this activity was carried out by the Ministry of Health.
- Currently, it is the National Accreditation Authority for Higher Education Institutions, established by the 2016 law, which has commissions for specific fields such as medicine.
 - Universities in the Czech Republic indeed enjoy a relatively high level of academic freedom.
- CMC is the advisory institution.

Do you have a shortage of physicians in your country?

- Yes, practically in all specializations.
- Moreover, the practicing doctors are aging.



Is there a plan in your country to increase the number of medical students? If yes, how does it look?

- Starting from the academic year 2019/2020, the government grant to universities was increased, enabling a 15% increase in the number of admitted medical students.
- Further increase in the student count is hindered by:
 - limited teaching spaces
 - shortage of educators physicians, who also have a relatively high average age.
 - The average age of associate professors (docent) is 55 years, and the average age of professors is 63 years.



Do you have any private medical schools in your country or are any private medical schools planned? If yes, are they geared to local or international students (e.g., other languages)?

- There are no private medical faculties in the Czech Republic.
- All public medical faculties offer English-language study programs (for profit).
